

PRESIDENTIAL REGULATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
NUMBER 104 OF 2015
ON
THE AMENDMENT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL REGULATION
NUMBER 69 OF 2015
ON
THE VISIT VISA EXEMPTION

WITH THE BLESSINGS OF GOD ALMIGHTY

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

- Considering:
- a. that in order to improve the relations between the Republic of Indonesia and other countries, a facility for foreign citizens of certain countries has been provided to enter the territory of the Republic of Indonesia which is implemented in the form of an exemption from the obligation to have a visit visa, including for tourism purpose under the principle of reciprocity and benefits;
 - b. that in order to improve the national economy in general and to increase the number of tourist arrivals in particular, it is necessary to increase the number of countries which granted an exemption from the obligation to have a visit visa for tourism;
 - c. that based on the considerations referred to in point a and point b, it is necessary to issue a Presidential Regulation on Amendment to the Presidential Regulation Number 69 of 2015 on the Visit Visa Exemption;

- Observing:
1. Article 4 section (1) of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia;
 2. Law Number 6 of 2011 on Immigration (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 52 of 2011, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5216);
 3. Government Regulation Number 31 of 2013 on the Implementing Regulations of Law Number 6 of 2011 on Immigration (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 63 of 2013, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia number 5409);
 4. Presidential Regulation Number 69 of 2015 on the Visit Visa Exemption (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 133 of 2015);

HAS DECIDED:

To Issue: A PRESIDENTIAL REGULATION ON THE AMENDMENT TO THE PRESIDENTIAL REGULATION NUMBER 69 OF 2015 ON THE VISIT VISA EXEMPTION.

Article I

Some provisions of the Presidential Regulation Number 69 of 2015 on the Visit Visa Exemption (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 133 of 2015) are amended as follows:

1. The provisions of Article 1 is added 1 (one) number as number 6, so Article 1 now reads as follows:

Article 1

In this Presidential Regulation:

1. A Foreigner is a person who is not a citizen of the Republic of Indonesia.
2. Tour is travel activities carried out by a person or a group of people visiting certain places for recreation, personal development, or learning the

uniqueness of the tour attractiveness visited in temporary period.

3. The Territory of the Republic of Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as Indonesian Territory is the entire Territory of Indonesia as well as certain zones under Law Number 6 of 2011 on Immigration.
 4. The Immigration Checkpoints are checkpoints at seaports, airports, border crossing posts, or any other places as the place to enter or exit Indonesia.
 5. A Visa of the Republic of Indonesia hereinafter referred to Visa is a written statement given by the authorized officials in a representative of the Republic of Indonesia or any other places designated by the government of the Republic of Indonesia that contains approval for foreigners to travel to Indonesian Territory and be the basis for granting a stay permit.
 6. The Minister is the minister administering law and human rights affairs.
2. The provisions of Article 3 section (2) and section (3) are amended so Article 3 now reads as follows:

Article 3

- (1) The Foreigners of certain countries are exempt from the obligation to have visit visa to enter and exit Indonesian Territory for tourism.
- (2) The Foreigners of certain countries as referred to in section (1) may enter and exit Indonesian Territory through certain Immigration Checkpoints.
- (3) The list of certain countries referred to in section

(1) is provided in Appendix I which is an integral part of this Presidential Regulation.

3. The provisions of Article 6 are amended so Article 6 now reads as follows:

Article 6

- (1) The Visit Visa Exemption has been issued to the Foreigner of certain countries and special administrative regions from particular country under the Presidential Regulation Number 18 of 2003 on Short Visit Visa Exemption, as amended several times, most recently by Presidential Regulation Number 43 of 2011 on the Third Amendment to the Presidential Regulation Number 18 of 2003 remains valid.
- (2) The Foreigners referred to in section (1) are exempt from the obligation to have Visa in order to engage in the government duty, educational, social, cultural, tourism, business, family activities, or transit.
- (3) The Foreigners referred to in section (2) may enter and exit Indonesian Territory through any Immigration Checkpoint.
- (4) The Foreigners referred to in section (3) are granted a stay permit for a length of stay 30 (thirty) days non extendable or convertible into any other kind of stay permit.
- (5) The list of certain countries and special administrative regions from a particular country as referred to in section (1) is provided in the Appendix II which is an integral part of this Presidential Regulation.

4. The provisions of Article 7 are amended so Article 7 now reads as follows:

Article 7

- (1) The procedure to enter and exit Indonesian Territory for Foreigners who obtain the Visit Visa Exemption will be regulated by a Ministerial Regulation.
- (2) The provisions on Immigration Checkpoints as referred to in Article 3 section (2) and Article 6 section (3) will be regulated by a Ministerial Regulation.

Article II

This Presidential Regulation comes into force on the date of its promulgation.

In order that every person may know hereof, it is ordered to promulgate this Presidential Regulation by its placement in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
